Choosing the best Janome needle for your project guarantees professional-looking results



## Blue Tip

*The premium Janome needle*

Specially designed for Janome embroidery machines. Use for all embroidery projects and general sewing on most fabric types.

## Red Tip

*Designed for denser embroidery*

Created in the same style as the classic Blue Tip needle, the Janome Red Tip needle provides the extra strength and durability needed for denser embroidery and thicker fabrics. This size 14 needle is equipped with a larger eye, which helps to prevent the thread breakage that can occur when working with tricky threads, such as metallic.

## Ball Point

*Preferred for stretch/knit fabrics*

Specially designed with a rounded tip that separates fabric fibers to prevent skipping stitches or damaging fabric. Use for fabrics such as cotton knits, tricot, jersey knits, and swimsuit fabric.

## Topstitch

*Ideal for decorative sewing*

Specially designed to accommodate heavier threads for decorative stitching. Choose needle size based on the weight of the fabric.

## Denim

*Preferred for heavyweight fabrics*

A special wedge-shaped tip produces optimum results on medium to heavyweight denim.

## Universal

*Preferred for woven fabrics*

For general purpose sewing on woven fabrics. Use for fabrics such as silks, cottons, linens and crepes. Choose needle size based on the weight of the fabric.

## Leather

*Preferred for genuine and faux leather*

Specially designed needle point provides smooth, even stitching. Use for leather and suede fabrics.

## NEEDLE TIPS

1. For best results, change the needle at the start of every new project and/or every 8 - 10 hours. And, remember to clean out the bobbin area after every project. These two, simple maintenance tips will prevent lint build up and result in perfect stitching.
2. If you don't have a twin or triple needle and need to sew rows of topstitching, take advantage of varying the needle positions on your Janome sewing machine.
3. When sewing with a twin needle, place wooly nylon thread in the bobbin. This will prevent a ridge of fabric between the two needles when you sew.
